As there are no walk in clinics in Somerset, and we are told not to use A and E unless it is a true emergency, this put us in a really horrible situation, which increased our stress. The primary school in Creech st Michael, and the secondary school in Monkton Heathfield are already getting very full, especially with the new development. This is something that will affect us. Lack of infrastructure, including services such as broadband and 4G. {Creech Heathfields broadband speeds are around 2MB, way below the average.} More congestion on the roads on the A38, towards the Creech Castle junction, for either joining the M5 or going to Taunton.
