Yet another planning application for CSM. I can echo most other comments made through multiple objections to another development. My greatest concerns are that of safety and provision of education services locally. Since there have been a number of new developments in CSM over the last 7 years there have benn ZERO road improvements to cater for the vast increase in traffic on the road. In fact none of recent developments over the last 7 years have even been completed, all sites and roads still remain un-adopted, pavements are yet to be completed and traffic stationary or moving is unregulated with the council and local PCSO showing no interest in taking any responsibility. Sadly I had a conversation with a family that have recently moved away from the village, the sole reason was so that their daughter would not have to walk along the 'death trap' road Hyde Lane when's she moves to Heathfield school in September. How the council can allow all these developments to happen without having any provision of improving the safety of pedestrians and vehicle users shows a disgraceful lack of responsibility and due care. As I have said on multiple occasions the impending death of someone on Hyde Lane will fall directly at the feet of the council who will be totally liable due to their choice to ignore all concerns of the public over pleasing property developers. The actions of the council over the last 7 years with regards to Creech st Michal are an utter disgrace, you should be ashamed of yourselves, constantly you put finance above common sense and safety.
