We object to the planning application for a further 200 houses in the parish of Creech St Michael. Surely this planned development would be outside the Core Strategy Policy? The field where the development is planned is prime agricultural land and contains a lot of wildlife, including deer. If planning consent was granted it would set a precedence and a large area of our remaining countryside around the village would disappear. The parish has had a lot of new buildings imposed upon it in recent years, despite local opposition and in excess of minor area development plans. The local primary school is overcrowded and there is still no sign of promised safe cycle access for children to attend the secondary school. We believe it is difficult to get appointments within a reasonable timescale at the doctors surgery and there are few local amenities - ie one shop\post office, pub and vets. Traffic levels are already causing difficulties as our village road is a rat run between the A38 and the A358. We also wish to mention also that there is an inadequate bus service. We believe that planning consent for these extra 200 houses should be rejected.
