I write in connection with the above planning application. I wish to object strongly to the development of these houses in this location for the reasons listed below: the lack of infrastructure; increased number of cars on narrow roads; oversubscribed schools and doctors surgery; loss of remaining natural barrier between the village of Creech St Michael and the motorway and urban sprawl; removing hedgerows for access will destroy wildlife habitat. We are very lucky to have recently moved into the village on a small new development in the last couple of years. The whole appeal of our move here was to be in a village, and this development will ruin the character of the village and more housing will overwhelm it. There is currently a development being built in the village at the moment, and not all of those houses have been sold. The area being put forward for development falls outside of the TDBC Core Strategy. There is no need for this kind of open market housing in the village.
