I am writing to express my dismay and objection to the application to have yet more houses built in Creech St Michael. We have lived here for just over two years, having moved from the South East. We bought here to have a more peaceful life and somewhere rural to bring up our young family.

In that time we have been horrified to see new estate upon new estate spring up all around us bringing in lots more people and lots more cars. We found the local facilities pretty dire beforehand and now I fear it's going to be stretched to breaking point. When we moved here I was pregnant with our first child and I saw no less than 7 midwives in that time. It was an awful experience and not one I wish to repeat with my current pregnancy. The services are inadequate, there's not enough infrastructure to support the growing population and the traffic is becoming far too heavy for such a small area. It is becoming far too urbanised and surely this can't help with the flooding issues? I feel adding any more houses to this already overstretched and under resourced community smacks of utter greed and contempt for the long suffering residents of Creech and surrounding villages. There are plenty of places elsewhere that need rejuvenating without impacting further on this community and the wildlife. The litter problem here is disgusting and that is definitely getting worse. I urge you to do the right thing and reject this proposal. Enough is enough.
