My objections are as follows: 1. The roads in the area are too narrow for the extra volume of traffic. Hyde Lane is being used by 64 tonne lorries - although they should not! Also, the traffic using the roads in the area have no respect for speed - even with traffic calming measures in place. The village is being used as a shortcut to get one side of Taunton to the other. 2. The increased traffic volume would cause increased risk to pedestrians - children walking to school etc. 3. Lack of infrastructure - where is the employment! 4. The schools in the area are oversubscribed, as well as the doctor's surgery. 5. Increased congestion at Bathpool. Also on the A38 and M5. 6. Loss of the remaining natural barrier between the village of Creech St. Michael and the motorway and urban sprawl. 7. Removing the hedgerows for access will destroy wildlife habitat. 8. Noise pollution - the M5 is already extremely busy, the additional housing would result in further increase in its use and therefore, the housing near to the motorway would be subjected to a harmful environmental stressor. The harmful effects of noise arise mainly from the stress reaction it causes in the human body, which can also occur during sleep.
