CREECH ST MICHAEL – GLADMANS**

I am objecting to the Gladman Planning Application because -

1. The area being put forward for development falls outside of the TDBC Core Strategy and should therefore not be considered
2. Our GP surgery is already unable to cope with the current number of patients and our schools are over subscribed
3. 200 houses means at least another 300+ cars on busy village roads where near accidents happen every day due to the lack of, and narrowness of pathways.
4. There is one village shop. The area around it is regularly congested due to lack of parking space.
5. The proposed site has been used as a leisure facility for walking and picnics with children for over 25 years. Yet another facility lost to our village to be replaced by children's equipment that will become vandalised and disused like other play areas in the village.
6. It is the last field that separates us from the M5 and the sprawling development on the other side.
7. The proposal mentions removing hedgerows for access. These are well established over many years, providing a habitat for wildlife and their loss will have detrimental visual impact on the approach to the village
